Summit is hosting *Shine your Smile Day...*
Smile Programs - Mobile Dentists on January 31st 2012!

The mobile dentists will have on-site dental care for primary students. Best of all, your child can receive dental care at **NO COST TO YOU**, as Medicaid, CHIP and most other insurances cover 100% of prevention treatment.

The dental team will set up a mini dental office in our building and provide dental services for all children who return completed forms. Dental services can be provided to families who need financial assistance, and there are subsidized fees for those who choose to pay for preventive care.

Signing up your children to see the mobile dental team is easy. Simply watch for the application which will be sent home, **Thursday, Jan. 12th**. If you want your child to see the dentist, just fill out the permission slip and return it to the school by **January 26th, 2012**.
